To make it lawful for any person to engage in or be present at certain activities on the Lord's Day (Bingo Lottery - Bramalea Boys Minor Softball Association)

WHEREAS the Bramalea Boys Minor Softball Association proposes to operate a bingo lottery on the dates set out in Schedule A to this by-law;

 $\,$ NOW THEREFORE the council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Subsection 1 (1) of the Lord's Day (Ontario) Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 253, as amended) is hereby declared to apply in the City of Brampton between 7:00 o'clock and 10:30 o'clock in the evening on the dates set out in Schedule A to this by-law, in respect of the bingo lottery to be conducted by the Bramalea Boys Minor Softball Association, at Brampton Bingo Country Project, 291 Rutherford Road South in Brampton.
- 2. All activities permitted by this by-law shall be conducted $\hat{\ }$ in an orderly manner.
