The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-Law 162-96 as amended by By-Law 243-96, By-Law 205-97, By-Law 260-97, By-Law 275-97 and By-Law 294-97, is hereby further amended as follows:
  - 1. Section 1 is amended by adding, before the words "The lands described as part of Lots 9 and 10, Concession 6, E.H.S," the following:
    - "Except as provided for in Section 1.3 and Section 1.4,"
  - 2. The following is added as Section 1.3:
    - "1.3 The lands described as Part of Lot 9, Concession 6, E.H.S. and referenced as the 'Lands Subject to Specific Exemption From Interim Control By-Law 162-96, as amended by By-Law 166-98as outlined on Schedule A to this by-law shall only permit an industrial use with open storage provided that it is screened such that the materials stored do not exceed the height of the screening."
  - 3. The following is added as Section 1.4:
    - "1.4 Shall be subject to the following requirements and restrictions:
      - (a) Minimum Side Yard Width 6.0 metres
      - (b) Minimum On-Site Parking 114 spaces
      - (c) Minimum Side Yard Landscaping 0 metres
      - (d) Minimum Landscaped Open Space
        - (1) 36 per cent of the required front yard area; and,

- (2) 0 per cent of the required side yard extending from the front yard to the rear wall of the rear most building."
- 4. Schedule A is deleted and replaced with Schedule A attached to this By-Law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL, this **15th** day of **July**, 1998.
