



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 167-91

A by-law to prohibit the throwing, placing or depositing of refuse or debris on private property or on property of the municipality or any local board thereof without authority from the owner or occupant of such property

WHEREAS pursuant to paragraph 76 of Section 210 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, c. 302 as amended, by-laws may be passed by the Council for prohibiting the throwing, placing or depositing of refuse or debris on private property or on property of the municipality or any local board thereof without authority from the owner or occupant of such property;

NOW THEREFORE the Council for the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

Definitions:

1. In this by-law,
 - a) "City" means the geographic entity City of Brampton in the Regional Municipality of Peel;
 - b) "City property" means any land situated within the City which is owned by the Corporation or controlled by the Corporation by lease or otherwise;
 - c) "Commissioner" means the Commissioner of Public Works & Building for the City of Brampton, or his designate;
 - d) "Corporation" means the Corporation of the City of Brampton;
 - e) "Local board" means any school board, public utility commission, transportation commission, public library board, local board of health, board of commissioners of police or any other board, commission, committee, board or local authority under any general or special Act with respect to the affairs or purposes, including school purposes, of the City of any part thereof;
 - f) "Officer" means a person appointed by by-law as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the City of Brampton;
 - g) "Owner" includes the registered owner, occupant, tenant, person for the time being managing or receiving the rent of the property whether on his own account or on account of an agent or trustee of any other person, or any one of the aforesaid;

- (h) "Private Property" means property which is privately owned and is not City property or property of a local board, property of the Regional Municipality of Peel or property of any of the Crown in Right of Ontario, the Crown in Right of Canada or any emanations thereof;
- (i) "Property" means lands, tenements and hereditaments and any estate or interest therein and any right or easement affecting the land;
- (j) "Refuse or debris" includes but is not limited to, garbage, ashes, rubbish, builder's and building contractors refuse, other industrial waste, inoperative vehicles and motor vehicle parts and accessories.
- (k) "Domestic Waste" includes household garbage, vegetables, fruits, furniture, clothing, household effects, septic tank liquor, wet and dry sewage disposal sludge, contents of privy vaults, cesspools and holding tanks for human excrement.

Administration

- 2. The Commissioner shall be responsible for administration and enforcement of this by-law.

Throwing of Refuse and Debris

- 3. (1) No person shall throw, place or deposit refuse, debris or domestic waste upon private property without the consent of the owner of the property.
- (2) No person shall throw, place or deposit refuse, debris or domestic waste on City property without the written consent of the Corporation.
- (3) No person shall throw, place or deposit refuse, debris or domestic waste on the property of a local board or the Regional Municipality of Peel, which property is situated in the City of Brampton, without the written consent of the local board or the Regional Municipality of Peel.

Signage



- 4. The presence of a "No Dumping" sign shall be deemed to indicate a lack of consent on the part of the owner.

Penalty

- 5. Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence, and liable upon conviction, to a penalty of not more than Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) exclusive of costs.
