# BY-LAW


To stop up and close and authorize the sale or lease of part of the lane on Registered Plan BR-14 and part of the Service Road on Registered Plan 541

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The part of the lane on Registered Plan BR-14 and the part of the Service Road on Registered Plan 541 illustrated on the sketch attached to this by-law as Schedule A are hereby stopped up and closed.
2. The part of the lane on Registered Plan BR-14 and the part of the Service Road and Lot 1 on Registered Plan 541 illustrated on the sketch attached to this by-law as Schedule B are hereby declared surplus.
3. The lease at current market value of part of the lane on Registered Plan BR-14 and the part of the Service Road and Lot 1 on Registered Plan 541 illustrated on the sketch attached to this by-law as Schedule B is hereby authorized.
4. City staff is hereby directed to obtain a legal land survey establishing the exact boundaries of the parcels illustrated on Schedules A and B forming part of this by-law.
5. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents approved by the City Solicitor that in his opinion are necessary to effect the lease of the land illustrated in Schedule B of this by-law.
6. The affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich attached as Schedule C forms part of this by-law.

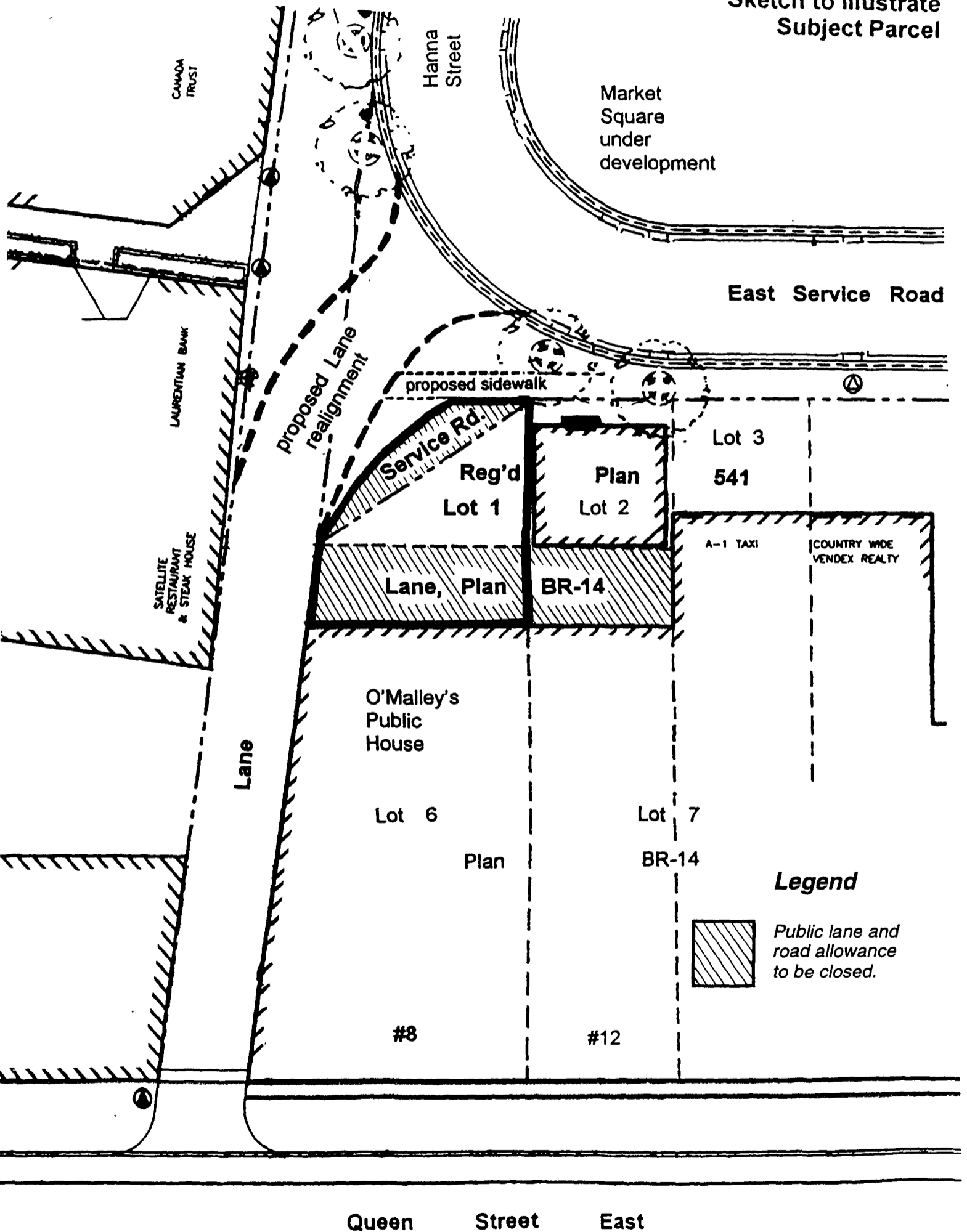

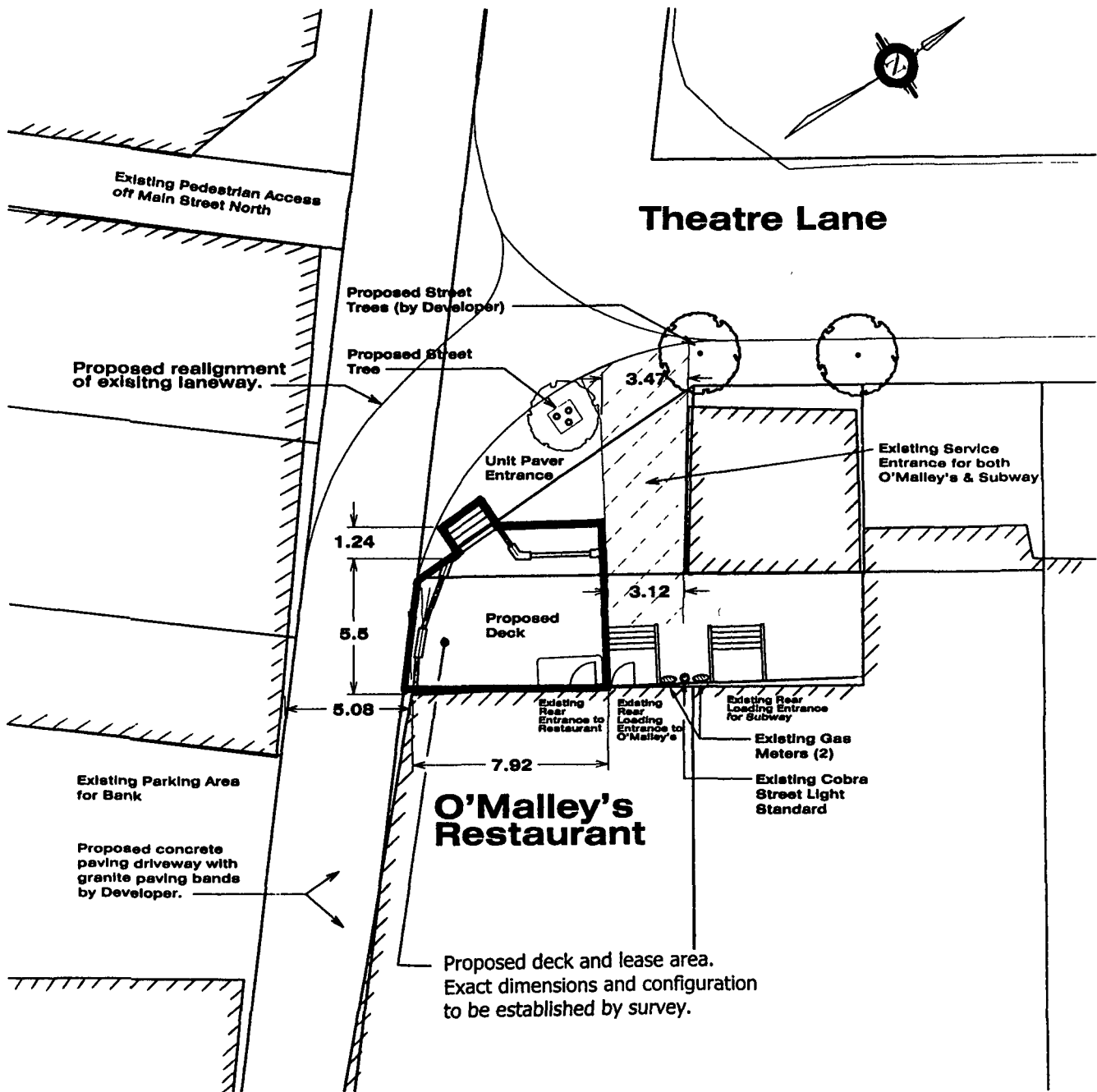

The Regional Municipality of Peel has advised that it has no objection to the said stopping up of part of the lane on Registered Plan BR-14 and part of the Service Road on Registered Plan 541.
- 4. The matter of the stopping up, closing and sale or lease of the part of the lane and Service Road described in this by-law came before City Council at its meeting of the 15<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1998. No persons applied to be heard in respect of this matter.
