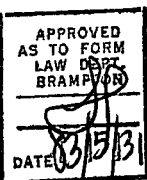
The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

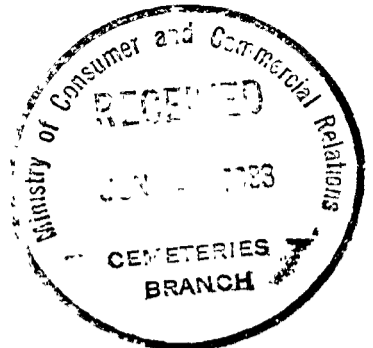
