BY-LAW

Number 168-84

To make it lawful for any person to engage in or be present at certain activities on the Lord's Day (Bingo Lottery - Chinguacousy Minor Hockey Association - Major Bantam AAA)

WHEREAS Chinguacousy Minor Hockey Association - Major Bantam AAA proposes to operate a bingo lottery on the dates set out in Schedule A to this by-law.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 1 (1) of the Lord's Day (Ontario) Act (R.S.O. 1980, c.253, as amended) is hereby declared to apply in the City of Brampton between 1:30 o'clock and 5:00 o'clock in the afternoon on the dates set out in Schedule A to this by-law, in respect of the bingo lottery to be conducted by Chinguacousy Minor Hockey Association - Minor Bantam AAA, at Bingo Country, 291 Rutherford Road in Brampton.

2. All activities permitted by this by-law shall be conducted in an orderly manner.
