To Amend By-law 13-74, to Prohibit the Parking or Leaving of Motor Vehicles on Municipal or Private Property without authority or where signs approved by the City have been posted designating the area as a Fire Route.


WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient and advisable to amend By-law Number 13-74;


NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That Section 8 of By-law Number 37-74 be and is hereby repealed and the following shall be substituted therefor:

(8) Notwithstanding all other provisions of this By-law, any person may, upon presentation of a parking violation tag issued under this By-law, pay out of Court within five days from the date of issue of the said tag, exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, the sum of \$5.00, and upon such payment, no further proceedings shall be taken under this By-law in respect of the said offence alleged in the parking violation tag.
2. This By-law shall not come into force or take effect until September 1st, 1977.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and passed in Open Council this 11th day of July, 1977.
