# BY-LAW

Number 173-77


Being a By-law to authorize the expropriation of certain lands in the City of Brampton.

WHEREAS it is the intention of the Corporation of the City of Brampton, as the expropriating authority, to expropriate those lands shown in Schedule "A" attached hereto for public purposes.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. The expropriation of the lands described in Schedule "A" is hereby authorized.
2. The Clerk is hereby authorized to sign notices and advertisements on behalf of the Corporation of the City of Brampton as required by The Expropriations Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 154, and amendments thereto.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 11th day of July, 1977.

SCHEDULE "A" to BY-LAW NUMBER 173-77

FIRSTLY, being composed of Part of Lot 1, according to a plan registered in the Registry Office of the Registry Division of Peel (No. 43), as Plan A-12, and being more particularly described as Part 1 according to a plan deposited in the said Registry Office as Plan No. 43R-4562;

SECONDLY, being composed of Part of Lot 11, according to a plan referred to as Plan BR-28 in the east half of Lot 5, Concession 1, West of Hurontario Street, and being more particularly described as Part 2 according to a plan deposited in the said Registry Office as Plan No. 43R-4562.
