To establish certain lands as
parts of public highways

WHEREAS By-law 74-80, passed on 24 March 1980, and registered in the Land Registry Office for the Registry Division of Peel (No. 43) on 31 March 1980 as Instrument Number 544757, purported to establish certain land as part of the public highway known as Bramalea Road, such land being described "SECONDLY" in Schedule A to the said by-law;


AND WHEREAS there was an error in the said description;
