## **BY-LAW**

Number <u>174-97</u>

To authorize the sale of certain surplus parkland

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that the land described herein is no longer required for the purposes of the Municipality.

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- The part of Block A, Registered Plan 809 abutting the south limit of the property known municipally as 8450 Torbram Road highlighted on the sketch attached as Schedule A to this by-law is hereby declared surplus. The sale of the land to Islamic Society of Peel at a price of \$3,500.00 per acre plus legal and survey costs is hereby authorized.
- 2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents approved by the City Solicitor that in his opinion are necessary to effect the transfer of the land described in this by-law.

**READ** a **FIRST, SECOND** and **THIRD TIME** and **PASSED** in Open Council this 13<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1997.
