BETWEEN: The Corporation of the City of Brampton

(Hereinaster called the "Corporation"

of the first part)

(Hereinafter called the "Contractor"

of the second part)

NITKESSETH

That the Corporation and the Contractor in consideration of the fulfillment of their respective promies and obligations herein set forth covenant and agree with each other as follows:-

ARTICLE 1 :

a) A general description of the work is:-

reconstruction of Railroad Street

b) The Contractor shall, except as otherwise specifically provided, at his own expense provide all and every kind of labour, machinery, plant, structures, roads, materials and appliances, articles and things necessary for the due execution and completion of all the work set out in this Contract art shall forth, the according to the instructions of the Engineer commence the works and diligently execute the respective portions thereof, and deliver the works complete in every particular to the Corporation within the time specified in the General Conditions of this Tender.

ARTICLE 2_:

In the event that the Tender provides for and contains a contingency allowance, it is understood and agreed that such contingency allowance is received for the convenience of accounting by the Corporation and the Contestor is not entitled to pay ent thereof except for extensional work or additional work cannot by him in accordance with the Contract and only to the extent of such extra or additional spoints.

FRICLE 3:

In case of inconsistency or conflict between the provisions of this Agreement and the Plans, or Specifications, or General Conditions, or Tender or any other document or writing the Provisions of such documents shall take precedence and govern in the following order, namely:

- 1. This Agreement
- 2. Special and/or Supplemental Provisions
- 3. Information for Tenderers
- 4. General Conditions
- 5. Standard Specifications
- 6. Plans
- 7. Tender

The foregoing documents enumerated one to seven including are all of the Contract Documents and constitute the full agreement between the parties.

ARTICLE 4

The Corporation covenants with the Contractor that the Contractor having in all respects complied with the Provisions of this Contract will be paid for the works included herein in accordance with the Unit Prices as set out in the Form of Tender, forming part of this Contract, and in accordance with the Provisions as set out in the Conditions and Specifications forming part of this Contract.

ARTICLE 5

Where any notice, direction or other communication is required to be or may he given or made by one of the parties hereto, to the other or to the Engineer, it shall be deemed sufficiently given or made if mailed by prepaid first class mail or delivered in writing to such party or to the Engineer at the following addresses:

A copy of each of the Contract Documents is hereto annexed and together with the Ministry of Transportation and Communications Specifications referred to in the Contract Documents and the Plans listed in the Specifications, are made part of this Contract as fully to all intents and purposes as though recited in full herein.

ARTICLE 7

No implied contract of any kind whatsoever by or in behalf of the Corporation shall arise or be implied from anything in this Contract contained, nor from any position or situation of the parties at anytime, it being clearly uncerstood that the express covenants and agreements herein contained made by the Corporation shall be the only covenants and agreements upon which any richts against the Corporation may be founded.

ARTICLE 8

Time shall be deemed the essence of this Contract.

ARTICLE 9

The Contractor declares that in tendering for the works and in entering into this Costract to his either inventigated for himself the chemittee of the exit in the material control is also then below ground acreed the time plication time. riight effect his Teaser or his acceptance of the Mork, or that not having so investigated is willing to assumed and does hereby assume all risk of conditions arising or developing in the course of the work which might or could make the work or any items thereof, more expensive in character, or more onerous to fulfill, than was contemplated or known when the Tender was made or the Contract signed. The Contractor also declares that he did not and dues not rely upon information funished by any methods whatsoever, by the Corporation or its' employees, being evere that any information from such sources was and is approximate, and speculative only, and was not in any manner warranted or quaranteed by the Corporation.

ARTICLE 10

This Contract shall apply to and be binding on the Parties hereto and their being, executors, administrators, successors and assigns and each of them.

Provided further and it is hereby agreed and declared that the Principal and the Surety shall not be discharged or released from liability hereus far and that such liability shall not be in any way affected by any such changes.
