BY-LAW

Number	177-2001	

To permit the owner of Lot 1, Registered Plan 43M-1347 to install a fence that encroaches onto the untravelled portion of Brinkley Drive

WHEREAS paragraph 3 of section 308 of the Municipal Act allows by-laws to be passed by the Council of every municipality for permitting any person under such conditions as may be agreed upon, to place, construct, install, maintain and use objects in, on, under or over sidewalks and highways under its jurisdiction;

AND WHEREAS the owner of Lot 1, Registered Plan 43M-1347 has requested permission to install a wrought iron fence that encroaches onto part of the untravelled portion of Brinkley Drive;

 ${\bf NOW}$ THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ${\bf ENACTS}$ AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The owner of Lot 1 on Registered Plan 43M-1347 is hereby permitted to erect a wrought iron fence onto part of the untravelled portion of Brinkley Drive on Plan 43M-1347, in the location shown on the sketch attached as Schedule A to this by-law.
- 2. It is a condition of the permission granted by this by-law that the owner of Lot 1 on Registered Plan 43M-1347 enter into a licence agreement with the City to the satisfaction of the Commissioner of Works and Transportation and the City Solicitor respecting the installation of the fence, the indemnification of the City and the provision of liability insurance.
- The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the agreement referred to in this by-law and all other documents that in the opinion of the City Solicitor are necessary to give effect of the provisions of this agreement.

READ a **FIRST, SECOND** and **THIRD TIME** and **PASSED** in Open Council this 25th day of June, 2001.
