

## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

## **BY-LAW**

Number 177-2004

To authorize the sale of a 50% interest in 0.30m reserves being Blocks 8 and 10, Registered Plan 43M-1184

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that the City's 50% interest in the 0.30 metre reserves being Blocks 8 and 10, Registered Plan 43M-1184 be sold to the owners of the abutting lands;

AND WHEREAS the City no longer requires the Lands and has agreed to reconvey the Lands;

AND WHEREAS the procedures required by section 268 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 have been carried out;

AND WHEREAS the Council The Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

- 1. The City's 50% interest in the 0.30 metre reserves being Blocks 8 and 10, Registered Plan 43M-1184 is hereby declared to be surplus.
- 2. The transfer for nominal consideration of the City's 50% interest in the 0.30 metre reserves being Blocks 8 and 10, Registered Plan 43M-1184 to the owner of the abutting lands is hereby authorized and the City Solicitor is hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments as may be necessary to effect the conveyance of the said lands.

**READ** a **FIRST**, **SECOND** and **THIRD** TIME and **PASSED** in Open Council this 28<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2004.
