

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M-1654
WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the <i>Planning Act</i> , R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;
AND WHEREAS , pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the <i>Planning Act</i> , the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the <i>Planning Act</i> does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;
AND WHEREAS , the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the <i>Planning</i> Act, on the lands described below for the purpose of creating a maintenance easement, is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;
NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:
1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the <i>Planning Act</i> does not apply to the following lands:
City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:
The whole of lot 136 on Registered Plan 43M-1654;
2.THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the <i>Planning Act</i> , this by-law shall expire on June 12 th , 2009 at the end of the business day
