# AMENDMENT NUMBER OP 93- 144 TO THE OFFICIAL PLAN OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON PLANNING AREA

#### 1.0 Purpose:

The purpose of this amendment is to facilitate the development of a retirement home, nursing home and senior's apartment building.

#### 2.0 Location

The lands subject to this amendment has an area of approximately 2.86 hectares(7.08 acres) and is located at the south-east corner of the northerly extension of Great Lakes Boulevard and Sandalwood Parkway East, within Lot 13, Concession 3, East of Hurontario Street.

## 3.0 <u>Amendment and Policies Relative Thereto</u>:

- 3.1 The document known as the Official Plan of the City of Brampton Planning Area is hereby amended:
  - (1) by adding to the list of amendments pertaining to Secondary Plan Area Number 28: Sandringham-Wellington, as set out in Part II: Secondary Plans, Amendment Number OP93- 144
- 3.2 The portions of the document known as the 1984 Official Plan of the City of Brampton Planning Area which remain in force, as they relate to the Sandringham-Wellington Secondary Plan (being Chapter 28 of Part IV-Secondary Plans, as amended) are hereby further amended:
  - (1) by changing on Schedule SP 28 thereto, the land use designation of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A to this amendment from "Public Senior Elementary School" to "Institutional";
  - (2) by adding after section 5.4.22 the following:

## "Nursing Home" (Oakwood Retirement Community)

- "5.4.23 The lands designated "Institutional (Nursing Home) on Schedule SP 28(A), at the south-east corner of Great Lakes Boulevard and Sandalwood Parkway East, may be used for nursing home, retirement home, apartment dwelling purposes and ancillary uses.
- Appropriate design and buffering shall be required in order to minimize the impact of the development on surrounding uses and address satisfactory interface between surrounding institutional blocks. Development standards shall be established by the implementing zoning by-law and the the exercise of site plan control pursuant to Section 40 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.
