



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 181-2013

To prevent the application of part lot control to
part of Registered Plan 43M - 1898

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, on the lands described below for the purpose of creating maintenance easements is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**


1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the following lands:


City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

The whole of Lots 62, 63, and 65 to 69, inclusive, 80 to 96, inclusive, 104 to 112, inclusive and Blocks 131 to 134, inclusive, on Registered Plan 43M-1898.


2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, this by-law shall expire at the end of the business day on June 19, 2016.
