BY-LAW

Number 184-80

To amend By-law 33-79
(regulation of traffic)

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient and advisable to amend By-law Number 33-79 being a By-law for the regulation of traffic.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 33-79, as amended, is hereby further amended by deleting Section (1) of Part 6 - PENALTIES and substituting therefor the following:

"Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and, upon conviction, is liable to a penalty of not more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00), exclusive of costs, for the first offence, and not more than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00), exclusive of costs, for each subsequent offence."
