Number 184-96

To declare surplus and authorize
the transfer of lands in exchange
for other lands.

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. The lands described in Schedule A to this by-law are hereby declared surplus to the needs of The Corporation of the City of Brampton (the "City").
2. The transfer of the lands described in Schedule A attached hereto in exchange for a transfer to the City of the lands described in Schedule B attached hereto is hereby authorized.
3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the transfer in a form approved by the Commissioner of Legal Services and City Solicitor, together with all other documents that, in the City Solicitor's opinion, are necessary to effect the said exchange of lands.
