# BY-LAW

Number 185-2000

**A by-law to provide for advance votes to be held prior to voting day, to provide for the use of vote counting equipment for the advance votes and to repeal By-law 129-97**

**WHEREAS** Section 43(1) of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996 provides that a municipal council shall pass a by-law establishing one or more dates for an advance vote, and the hours during which voting places shall be open on that date or dates;


**AND WHEREAS** Section 42 of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996 provides that a municipal council may pass a by-law authorizing the use of vote counting equipment;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton enacts as follows:


1. Advance voting shall be held on the following dates at the times and locations noted, with respect to the Municipal Election to be held November 13, 2000:
  - (a) Saturday, November 4, 2000 between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. at City Hall, 2 Wellington Street West and Civic Centre, 150 Central Park Drive;
  - (b) Monday to Wednesday, November 6 to 8, 2000 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. at City Hall, 2 Wellington Street West.
2. The use of vote counting equipment is hereby authorized with respect to advance voting for the 2000 Municipal Election.
3. By-law 129-97 is hereby repealed.

Read a first, second and third time and passed in open Council this 11<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2000.
