WHEREAS The Region of Peel Agricultural Society represents that it is a society to which <u>The Agricultural Societies Act</u> applies;

AND WHEREAS the said Society proposes to hold part of its annual fair on Sunday the 14th day of September, 1980;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of The City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:-

- 1. Section 6 of The Lord's Day (Ontario) Act, (R.S.O. 1970, C.59, as amended) is hereby declared to apply within the City of Brampton in respect of the exhibition or show conducted by The Region of Peel Agricultural Society on the fairgrounds at Elliott Street in Brampton, and in respect of all activities provided in connection therewith, including a horse show, and the operation of a "midway", with shows, rides, games and concessions.
- 2. The activities specified in section 1 of this by-law shall be permitted only between 12 noon and 6:00 p.m. in the afternoon of Sunday, the 14th day of September, 1980, but nothing in this section shall in any way limit the time during which the said Society may conduct any aspect of its fair which is not unlawful under <a href="https://doi.org/10.1001/journal.org/">The Lord's Day Act (Canada)</a>.

3. The Region of Peel Agricultural Society shall conduct the activities hereby permitted in an orderly manner.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 7th day of July, 1980.
