


## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON





To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan **43M-1480** 

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

**AND WHEREAS**, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

**AND WHEREAS**, the application for an exemption from part lot control pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning* Act, on the lands described below, for the purposes creating maintenance easements, is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

Lots 9, 10, 13, 14, 74, 122, 123, 142, 143, 155, 156, 157 and 158 on Registered Plan 43M-1480.

2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, this by-law shall expire on June 27, 2006.

**READ** a **FIRST, SECOND** and **THIRD TIME** and **PASSED** in Open Council this 27th day of June 2005.
