BY-LAW

Number 190-88

To amend By-law 861 (part of
Lot 3, Concession 5, E.H.S.,
in the geographic Township
of Chinguacousy

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 861, as amended, and as specifically amended by By-law 152-87 is hereby further amended:

- (1) by deleting section 507.1.1(9) thereof and substituting therefor the following:

"507.1.1(9) a retail outlet for new gardening equipment operated in connection with a gardening equipment repair and service operation provided that the total gross commercial floor area of the retail outlet when combined with the retail outlet permitted by section 507.1.1(8) is not more than 15 percent of the total gross industrial floor area of the repair and service operation or 28 square metres, whichever is the greater, and"

- (2) by adding to section 507.1.1 thereof the following:

"507.1.1(10) purposes accessory to the other permitted purposes."

- (3) by deleting section 507.1.2(9) thereof and substituting therefor the following:

"507.1.2(9) no storage or display of goods shall be permitted outside the buildings;"

- (4) by adding to section 507.1.2 thereof the following:


"507.1.2(10) the sale of farm equipment shall not be permitted."
