



## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

## **BY-LAW**

Number 190-2004

A by-law to provide for certain matters under the *Line Fences Act* and to repeal By-law 70-91 as amended

WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton has by By-law 9-74 declared that the *Line Fences Act* applies in the City of Brampton;

**AND WHEREAS** it is deemed expedient and advisable to appoint fence-viewers for the City of Brampton, to establish the honorarium paid to fence-viewers, to provide that no proceeding requiring the attendance or re-attendance of fence-viewers shall be scheduled during the winter months, and to repeal By-law 70-91 as amended as a matter of housekeeping;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:** 

1. That the following persons be and are hereby appointed fence-viewers for the City of Brampton, for the term of office ending November 30, 2006, or until their successors are appointed:

Douglas Godlington James Pace Raymond Ramdayal Murray Van Halem J. Leslie Wilson

- 2. Each fence-viewer shall receive an honorarium of \$60.00 (Sixty Dollars), which amount includes payment for mileage, for each attendance or reattendance by that fence-viewer in a proceeding under the *Line Fences Act*. The fence-viewer who writes up the award and delivers it to the City Clerk's Office shall receive an additional honorarium of \$10.00 (Ten Dollars).
- 3. No arbitration or other proceeding under the *Line Fences Act* that requires the attendance or re-attendance of the fence-viewers shall be scheduled between the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November in any year and the 31<sup>st</sup> day of March in the next following year.

4. By-law 70-91, as amended, is hereby REPEALED.
