To amend By-law 200-82, as amended.

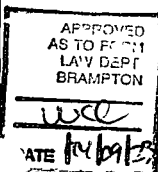
The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton

COUNCIL, this 26th day of September 1994.

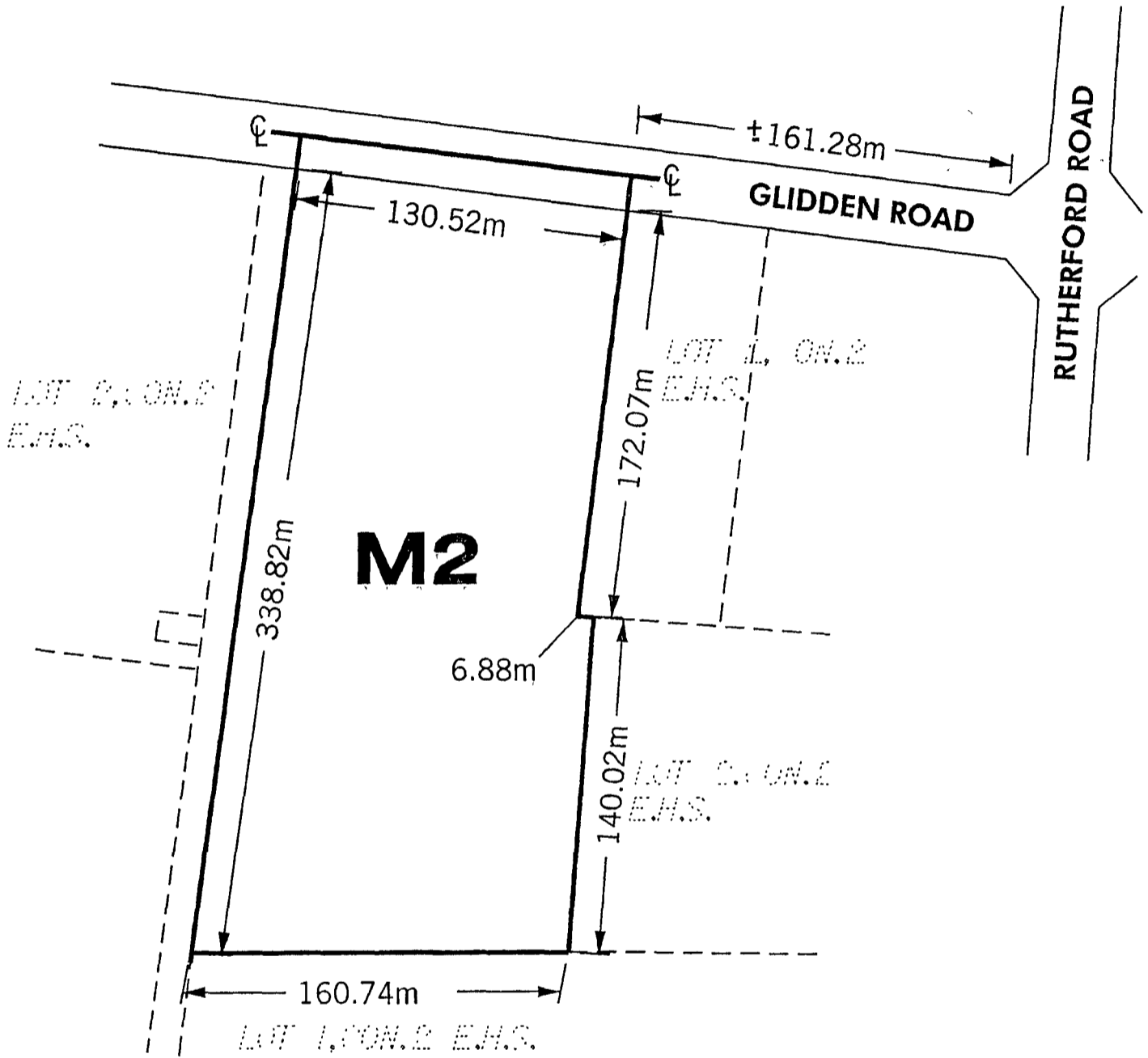

- m METRES



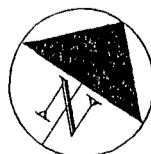
**PART LOT 2, CON. 2 E.H.S.**
