A By-law to amend Traffic By-law 93-93, to make housekeeping amendment with respect to parked or standing vehicles interfering with snow removal and/or winter maintenance activities

WHEREAS Subsection 11(3) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 permits a local municipality to pass by-laws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Brampton wishes to make a house keeping amendment with respect to parked of standing vehicles interfering with snow removal and/or winter maintenance activities;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 93-93, as amended, is further amended as follows:
 - (1) Section 44 of the Traffic By-law 93-93 is replaced by the following:

PARKING OR STANDING INTERFERING WITH SNOW REMOVAL AND/OR WINTER MAINTENANCE ACTIVITIES

44 Notwithstanding any other provision of this by-law which permits the parking of vehicles on highways, no person shall park or stand a vehicle on a highway in such a manner as to interfere with snow removal and/or winter maintenance activities. READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in OPEN COUNCIL, this 22nd day of June, 2011.
