Number 197-2006
To authorize the execution of the
GTA Fare System Operational Agreement

WHEREAS on February 23, 2006, Brampton City Council authorized the execution of the GTA Fare System Procurement Governance Agreement to formalize Brampton's participation in the development of the GTA Fare System;

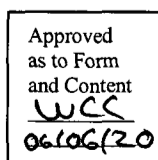
AND WHEREAS the Procurement Governance Agreement contemplated the creation of an operating agreement to set out the rights and obligations of the parties once the GTA Fare System becomes operational;


AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton may pass by-laws relating to a bus passenger transportation system pursuant to section 11 of the Municipal Act, 2001 S.O. 2001 c.25, as amended;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to execute the GTA Fare System Operational Agreement (the "Agreement") between Her Majesty the Queen in Right of the Province of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Transportation for the Province of Ontario, Greater Toronto Transit Authority, The Corporation of the City of Brampton and other participating municipalities and transit authorities, in a form approved by the City Solicitor and the Director of Transit.
2. That the Director of Transit and the Manager of Business Strategies be appointed as Brampton's representatives on the Executive Committee and Steering Committee respectively that are established pursuant to the Agreement and that they be given authority to perform any action and provide any required recommendations, instructions and approvals to fulfill the mandate of each committee, including the authority to appoint alternate members to the Committees to perform the above in their absence.
3. That the Director of Transit or her designate be authorized to execute any additional documents that may be required pursuant to the Agreement in a form approved by the City Solicitor.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 26th day of June, 2006.
