



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 198-2007

To authorize the permanent closure of part of the
Road Allowance between Concessions 2 and 3 W.H.S
known as Chinguacousy Road and surplus declaration of land.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of the Corporation of the City of Brampton that the part of the Road Allowance between Concessions 2 and 3 W.H.S known as Chinguacousy Road described in Schedule A to this by-law ("Closed Road Part") be permanently closed;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of the Corporation of the City of Brampton that the Closed Road Part, described in Schedule A be declared surplus;


AND WHEREAS pursuant to By-laws 393-2002 and 273-2005 notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published in the Brampton Guardian newspaper a minimum of five and not more than twenty-one days prior to the Council meeting at which this by-law was considered:


AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;


NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The part of the Road Allowance between Concessions 2 and 3 W.H.S. known as Chinguacousy Road described in Schedule A to this by-law is hereby permanently closed.
2. Subject to the registration of the by-law closing the Closed Road Part, the Closed Road Part as described in Schedule A are declared surplus.
3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments approved by the City Solicitor as may be necessary to give effect to this by-law.

SCHEDULE "A" TO BY-LAW 198-2007

Part of the Road Allowance between Concessions 2 and 3 W.H.S. originally dedicated as Highway by By-law 6808 (Instrument No. 53685VS) of the former Corporation of the Township of Toronto
