# BY-LAW

Number 200-76

Being a by-law to authorize  
the expropriation of certain  
lands in the City of Brampton

WHEREAS it is the intention of the Corporation of the City of Brampton, as the expropriating authority, to expropriate those lands shown in Schedule "A" attached hereto for public purposes.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. The expropriation of the lands described in Schedule "A" is hereby authorized.
2. The Clerk is hereby authorized to sign notices and advertisements on behalf of the Corporation of the City of Brampton as required by The Expropriations Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 154, and amendments thereto.

SCHEDULE "A"

FIRSTLY, being composed of part of Lot 4, according to a plan registered in the Registry Office of the Registry Division of Peel (No. 43) as Plan 601, and being more particularly described as Part 19 according to a plan deposited in the said Registry Office as Plan Number 43R-2523;

SECONDLY, being composed of part of Lot 4, according to a plan registered in the Registry Office of the Registry Division of Peel (No. 43) as Plan 601, and being more particularly described as Part 20 according to a plan deposited in the said Registry Office as Plan Number 43R-2523;

THIRDLY, being composed of part of Lot 1, according to a plan registered in the Registry Office of the Registry Division of Peel (No. 43) as Plan 601, and being more particularly described as Part 24 according to a plan deposited in the said Registry Office as Plan Number 43R-2523; and

FOURTHLY, being composed of part of Lot 7, Concession 1, East of Hurontario Street, in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel, formerly in the Township of Chinguacousy, in the County of Peel, and being more particularly described as Part 25 according to a plan deposited in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of Peel (No. 43) as Plan Number 43R-2523.
