BY-LAW

Number _____ 202-94 ____

To stop up and close and authorize the sale or lease of part of California Street

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that the part of California Street described in Schedule A to this by-law be stopped up and closed and that the sale or lease of the said lands be authorized;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the Brampton Guardian, a newspaper published in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the said Corporation has given notice to The Regional Municipality of Peel, pursuant to Section 44 of the <u>Regional Municipalities Act</u> (R.S.O. 1990, c.R.8, as amended) and The Regional Municipality of Peel has indicated that it does not object to such stopping up;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The part of California Street described in Schedule A on this by-law is hereby stopped up and closed.
- 2. The sale or lease of the said lands is hereby authorized. The intended lessee or purchaser and the rent or purchase price to be charged shall be determined by a subsequent by-law of Council.
- 3. The affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich attached as Schedule B to this by-law forms part of this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND, and THIRD TIME, and PASSED in open Council this 11th day of October, 1994.

Billett, Director of Development Control for The Regional Municipality of Peel, to whom the Region delegated approving authority for street closures, indicated by letter to the City of Brampton that The Regional Municipality of Peel had no objection to the said stopping up, closure and sale or lease of the part of California Street herein described.
- 4. The matter of the stopping up, closure and sale or lease of the part of California Street herein described came before City Council at its meeting of the 11th day of October, 1994. No persons applied to be heard in respect of this matter.
