A By-law to provide for composite ballots.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to provide for composite ballots at the Municipal Election pursuant to the provisions of The Municipal Elections Act, 1977.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. A composite ballot containing the names of the candidates for the offices of Mayor, Member of Regional Council and Member of City Council, shall be used at all Municipal Elections.
- 2. A composite ballot containing the names of candidates for the offices of Member of the Dufferin-Peel Roman Catholic Separate School Board and Separate School Trustee on the Peel Board of Education for Secondary School Purposes, shall be used at all Municipal Elections.
- 3. The ballots shall be in the form attached to and forming part of this By-law and shall contain the names of the candidates for each office, arranged in alphabetical order, according to their surnames and, if the surnames are identical, according to their given names.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and Passed in Open Council this 11th day of September, 1978.


