
To divide the municipality into
areas under the Education Act
1974 as amended


WHEREAS the Education Act 1974 as amended permits a Council by By-law to divide the municipality into two or more areas and provide for the election of one or more members in each such area;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- (1) That the Corporation of the City of Brampton shall be divided into two areas for elections under the Education Act 1974 as amended for separate school electors, with two members to be elected by the separate school electors for each area.
- (2) The areas referred to in Clause (1) shall be as follows:
 - (a) All lands within the boundaries of the City of Brampton lying west of the centre line of Heart Lake Road and;
 - (b) All lands within the boundaries of the City of Brampton lying east of the centre line of Heart Lake Road.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 11th day of August, 1980.
