an agreement with Peel Memorial
Hospital Association


WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton requires certain lands from the Peel Memorial Hospital Association in order to construct the Centre Street Grade Separation;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton and the Peel Memorial Hospital Association have reached an agreement respecting compensation payable by the City for the lands and certain other matters connected with the grade separation project;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute an agreement in a form approved by the City Solicitor between the Peel Memorial Hospital Association and The Corporation of the City of Brampton respecting the conveyance of the lands required by the City for the Centre Street Grade Separation project and the compensation payable therefore, together with all other documents which in the opinion of the City Solicitor are necessary to effect the said conveyance and ensure the completion of the said project.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 14th day of July, 1986.
