Number 206 - 2011

A By-law to amend Traffic By-law 93-93, to create Three Hour Parking Limit Exemptions

WHEREAS Subsection 11(3) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 permits a local municipality to pass by-laws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Brampton wishes to institute exemptions to the citywide three (3) hour parking limit and has so provided in this by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 93-93, as amended, is further amended as follows:
 - (1) Section 42 (8) of the Traffic By-law 93-93 is replaced by the following:
 - 42 (8) on any highway for a period longer than three (3) hours unless otherwise permitted by authorized signs erected at the locations set out in Schedule XXXV of this By-law;
 - (2) by adding the attachment to this by-law called "Schedule XXXV" as Schedule XXXV of Traffic By-law 93-93.

SCHEDULE XXXV

THREE HOUR PARKING LIMIT EXEMPTIONS

COLUMN 1 HIGHWAY	COLUMN 2 SIDE	COLUMN 3 BETWEEN
Market Street	South	A point 128 metres west of Thomas Street and a point 9 metres west of Thomas Street
Market Street	South	A point 15 metres east of Thomas Street and a point 48 metres east of Thomas Street
Thomas Street	South	A point 9 metres south of Market Street and a point 91 metres south of Market Street
