Number _______ To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M-778 and 43M-779 (Kingknoll Developments Ltd.)

WHEREAS subsection 49(5) of the <u>Planning Act, 1983</u> has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 49(7) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, <u>1983</u>, the council of a municipality may by by-law provide that part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans or parts thereof as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:
