WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to accept and assume Industrial Street as shown on Registered Plan 452 as a public highway;

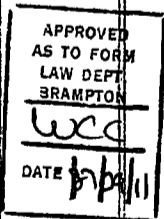
NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:
