BY-LAW

Number 210-97

To declare surplus and authorize the transfer of lands.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has considered a request for a transfer of the lands described in this by-law.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The lands described in Schedule A to this by-law are hereby declared to be surplus to the needs of The Corporation of the City of Brampton.
- 2. The transfer of the lands described in column 1 of Schedule A attached hereto for the price set out in column 2 of Schedule A attached hereto is hereby authorized.
- 3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the transfers of these lands in a form approved by the Commissioner of Legal Services and City Solicitor, together with all other documents that, in the Commissioner's opinion, are necessary to effect the said transfers of land.
