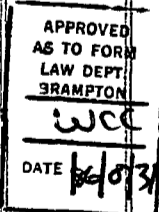
To accept a conveyance of land
(reserves along Highway 10)

WHEREAS The Ministry of Transportation and Communications has transferred jurisdiction of part of Highway No. 10 running through the City of Brampton to The Corporation of the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient for certain reserves abutting Highway No. 10 to be transferred to The Corporation of the City of Brampton;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. The acquisition of the lands described in Schedule A hereto for the price of One Dollar (\$1.00) from HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN, in right of the Province of Ontario, represented by the Minister of Transportation and Communications for the Province of Ontario, is hereby authorized.




2. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents approved by the City Solicitor which are necessary to effect the said acquisition.

SCHEDULE A 211-86

FIRSTLY:

Parcel 1' res. - Section M-169 being one foot reserves Blocks P and Q on Plan M-169.

SECONDLY:

Parcel 0.30m Reserves - 2 Section 43M-523 being 0.30m Reserves Blocks 114 and 115 on Plan 43M-523.

Subject to an easement in favour of Bell Canada as described in Instrument Number 64063.

THIRDLY:

Parcel 0.30 Metre Reserve - 1 Section 43M-553 being 0.30m Reserve Block 142 on Plan 43M-553.

FOURTHLY:

Parcel 14-6 Section 43 - Tor. Twp. - 1 (E.H.S.) being Part of Lot 14 Concession 1, East of Hurontario Street, designated as Part 9 on Plan 43R-11597.

Subject to an Easement in favour of Bell Canada as described in Instrument Number 64063.
