To amend By-law 270-2004, as amended

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 270-2004, as amended, is hereby further amended:


(1) by DELETING Section 20.3.3 in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

“20.3.3 The lands shown outlined and identified as “Parking Exemption Area” on Schedule B-5 to this by-law shall be exempt from the requirements set out in Section 20.3.1 and Section 20.3.2 for a commercial use only, and for a temporary period expiring on June 30, 2016.”


(2) by DELETING Schedule B-5 and replacing it with the revised Schedule B-5 as shown on Schedule A to this By-law.

this 7th day of August 2013.

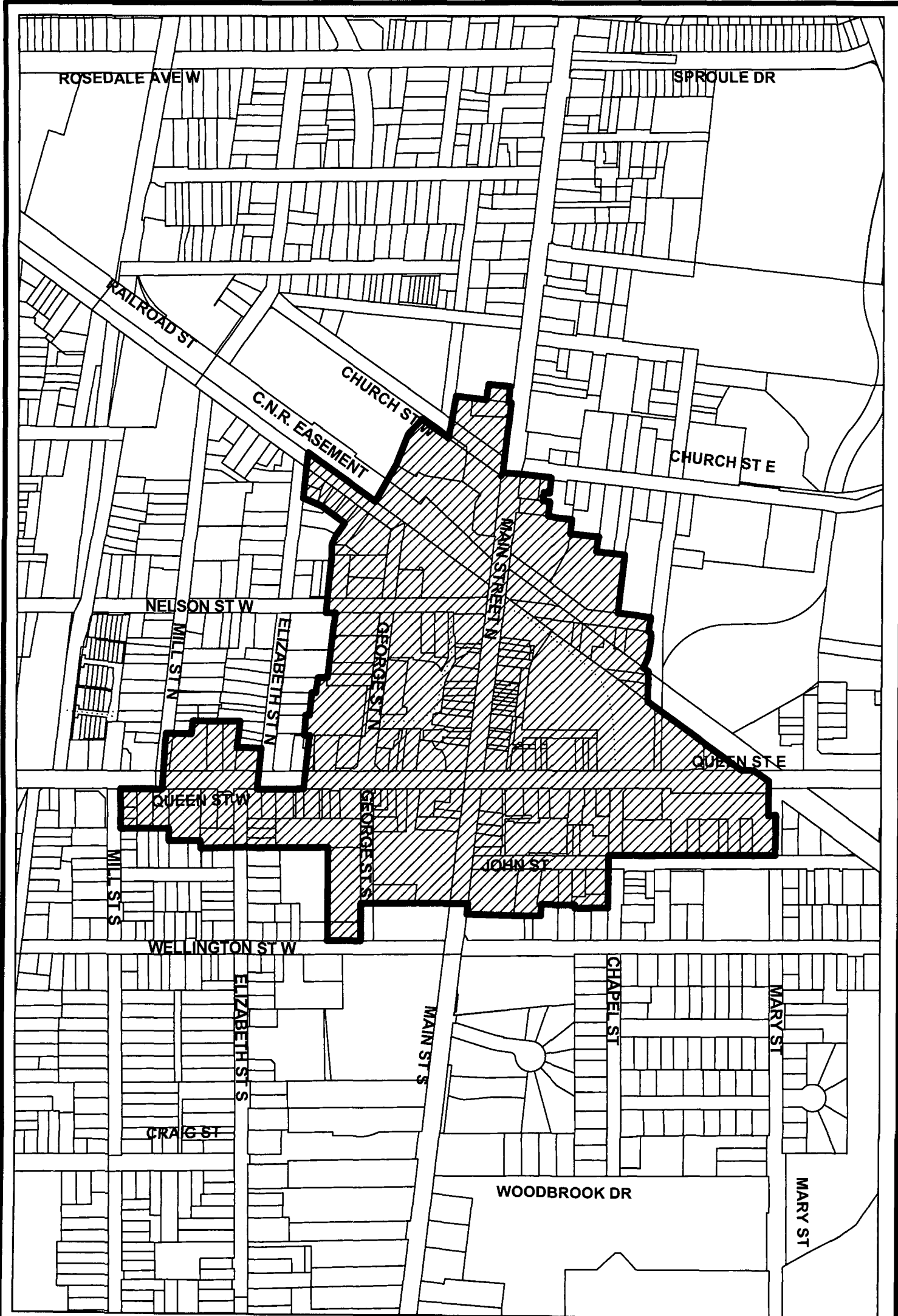
