

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number	215-98
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To authorize the sale of part of Bovaird Drive

WHEREAS The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton passed By-law 38-80, registered as Instrument No. 542453, which stopped up and closed the part of Bovaird Drive described in Schedule A to this by-law;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient to sell the said lands to the Regional Municipality of Peel, being the road authority responsible for Bovaird Drive;


AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this bylaw has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in The Brampton Guardian, a newspaper published in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS notice has been served on the Regional Municipality of Peel pursuant to section 44 of the Regional Municipalities Act and the Regional Municipality of Peel has indicated that it does not object to this by-law;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the said corporation has heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The sale of the part of Bovaird Drive more particularly described in Schedule A to this by-law to the Regional Municipality of Peel for the sum of \$2.00 is hereby authorized.
- 2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments in the opinion of the City Solicitor are necessary to effect the conveyance of the said lands.
- 3. The affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich attached as Schedule B forms part of this by-law.

D. R. Billett, Director of Development Control for the Region, to whom the Region delegated approving authority for street closures, indicated to the City of Brampton that The Regional Municipality of Peel had no objection.
- 4. The matter of the proposed enactment of this by-law came before City Council at its meeting of the 28th day of September, 1998. No persons applied to be heard in respect of this matter.
