# BY-LAW

Number 215-2011

A By-law to Amend By-law 122-2011  
being the Appointment By-law for  
Municipal By-law Enforcement Officers  
(Summer Inspectors)

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WHEREAS section 9 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* (S.O. 2001, c. M.25, as amended) gives powers and privileges of a natural person for exercising its authority under the *Municipal Act, 2001* or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS section 227 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* (S.O. 2001, c. M.25, as amended) establishes the role of employees to carry out duties required or assigned under the *Municipal Act, 2001* or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS section 15 of the *Police Services Act* (R.S.O. 1990, c.P.15) authorizes the appointment of Municipal Law Enforcement Officers who shall be peace officers for the purposes of enforcing the by-laws of the Municipality;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton enacts as follows:

1. The following persons are hereby appointed as Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the City of Brampton from September 3, 2011 to November 4, 2011:

2. A municipal law enforcement officer appointed by this By-law may enter on land at any reasonable time for the purpose of carrying out an inspection to determine whether or not the following are being complied with:
  - (a) a by-law of The Corporation of the City of Brampton passed under the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended;
  - (b) a direction or order of The Corporation of the City of Brampton made under the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended, or made under a by-law;
  - (c) a condition of a license issued under a by-law; or
  - (d) an order made under section 431 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended.

3. An municipal law enforcement officer exercising a power of entry may:
  - (i) require production for inspection of documents or things relevant to the inspection;
  - (ii) inspect and remove documents or things relevant to the inspection for the purpose of making copies or extracts;
  - (iii) require information from any person concerning a matter related to the inspection; and
  - (iv) alone or in conjunction with a person possessing special or expert knowledge, make examinations or take tests, samples or photographs necessary for the purposes of the inspection.
4. Subject to section 5, this By-law prevails to the extent of any conflict between this By-law and any other by-law of The Corporation of the City of Brampton.
5. This by-law does not restrict any rights conferred by the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended, or any other Act or regulation, respecting entry to land.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD time and PASSED in open Council, this 13th day of July, 2011.
