

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 216-2002

To permit the use of part of the untravelled portion of Torbram Road for landscaping purposes

Paragraph 3 of Section 308 of the <u>Municipal Act</u> authorizes the Council of every municipality to pass by-laws permitting any person under such conditions as may be agreed to place, construct, install, maintain and use objects in, on under or over highways under its jurisdiction.

1503574 Ontario Inc. has applied to The Corporation of the City of Brampton for approval to place landscaping on part of the untravelled portion of Torbram Road abutting its property.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. 1503574 Ontario Inc. is hereby permitted to place and maintain landscaping on the part of the untravelled portion of Torbram Road highlighted and labeled "Premises" on Schedule A attached to this By-law.
- 2. The permission granted in section 1 is subject to the terms and conditions set out in a licence agreement dated August 6, 2002 between The Corporation of the City of Brampton and 1503574 Ontario Inc. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the licence agreement.


