A By-law to amend By-law 93-93 the Traffic By-law of the City of Brampton

The Council of The Corporation of The City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 93-93, the Traffic By-law, is hereby amended as follows:

(1) By adding to section 40 a new subsection (3) as follows:

"40 (3) The provisions of section 40 subsection (1) shall not apply to vehicles which clearly display in a visible manner a disabled permit except that the wheels of such vehicle which are closest to the curb shall be parallel to and not more than 15 cm (6in.) from the curb or limit of the highway"

(2) By adding to section 42 a new subsection (14) as follows:

"42 (14) The provisions of section 42 subsection (11) & (12) shall not apply to vehicles which clearly display in a visible manner a disabled permit."

(3) By adding as section 49.1 the following:

"49.1 The provisions of section 49 shall not apply to vehicles which clearly display in a visible manner a disabled permit."

(4) By adding as section 51.1 the following:

"51.1. The provisions of section 51 shall not apply to vehicles which clearly display in a visible manner a disabled permit."

(5) By adding to section 2, Definitions, the following:

"disabled permit" shall mean a valid subsisting permit issued to a person with disabilities by the Ministry of Transportation"
