BY-LAW

Number	217-90	

To amend By-law 200-82, (part of Lot 7, Concession 1, W.H.S., geographic Township of Chinguacousy)

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 200-82, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - (1) by changing, on Sheet 5 of Schedule 'A' thereto, the zoning designation of the lands shown on Schedule A to this by-law from INDUSTRIAL ONE (M1) to INDUSTRIAL ONE-SECTION 344 (M1-SECTION 344), such lands being part of Lot 7, Concession 1, West of Hurontario Street, geographic Township of Chinguacousy.
 - (2) by adding thereto, the following sections:
 - "344 The lands designated M1-SECTION 344 on Sheet 5 of Schedule A to this by-law:
 - 344.1 shall only be used for the purposes permitted by section 31.1.1.
 - 344.2 shall be subject to the following requirements and restrictions:
 - (a) Minimum Interior Side Yard Width: 1.2 metres where it abuts a residential zone.
 - (b) Minimum Lot Width: 19.5 metres.

shall also be subject to the 344.3 requirements relating to the M1 zone and all general provisions of this by-law which are not in conflict with the ones set out in section 344.2".

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN 10th day of October 1990


