# BY-LAW

Number 218-94

To authorize the execution of minutes of settlement on assessment appeals and to repeal By-law 52-88

By-law 52-88 authorized the Chief Administrative Officer and Treasurer to execute minutes of settlement arising out of assessment appeals. This by-law reflects that the Chief Administrative Officer is now the City Manager and the Treasurer is a separate office.

**ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The City Manager or the Treasurer are hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton, minutes of settlement arising out of assessment appeals at the Assessment Review Board or the Ontario Municipal Board that, in the opinion of the signing officer, are in the best interests of The Corporation of the City of Brampton.
2. By-law 52-88 is hereby repealed.
