
Notice of By-law 219-82, passed by the Council of The Corporation

I, RALPH A. EVERETT of the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel MAKE OATH AND SAY AS FOLLOWS:


1. I am employed as Clerk of The Corporation of the City of Brampton, and as such have knowledge of the matters hereinafter declared.

A by-law to stop up and close and

authorize the sale of certain

parts of Copper Road

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that a certain part of Copper Road be stopped up and closed, and sold to the owners of the abutting lands;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the Daily Times a newspaper published in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the said Corporation has given notice to The Regional Municipality of Peel, pursuant to section 49 of the Regional Municipality of Peel Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 440, as amended) and the Regional Municipality of Peel has indicated that it does not object to such stopping up;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The part of Copper Road more particularly described in Schedule A attached to this by-law be and the same is hereby stopped up and closed.

- 2. The sale of the lands stopped up and closed by this by-law, to the owners of the abutting lands, for the sum of \$10,000.00 including costs is hereby authorized.
- 3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments as may be necessary to effect the conveyance of the lands stopped up and closed by this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 13th day of October , 1982.
