## **BY-LAW**

A by-law to constitute and appoint a Committee of Adjustment under the Planning Act, 1983, to prescribe a tariff of fees for Committee of Adjustment applications and to provide for remuneration

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 43(1) of the Planning Act, 1983 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton (hereinafter referred to as the "Council") may by by-law constitute and appoint a Committee of Adjustment;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to section 44(3) of the Planning Act, the Council may empower the Committee to grant minor variances to any by-law that implements an Official Plan;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to section 68(1) of the Act, the Council may by by-law prescribe a tariff of fees for the processing of applications made to the Committee of Adjustment;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to section 43(9) of the Act, the members of the Committee shall be paid such compensation as the Council may provide;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

That a Committee of Adjustment for the City of Brampton

(hereinafter referred to as the "Committee of Adjustment")

is hereby constituted and the persons listed on Schedule

A attached hereto and forming part of this by-law are

hereby appointed to the Committee of Adjustment.

- 2. That the Council hereby empowers the Committee of
  Adjustment to grant minor variances from the
  provisions of any by-law that emplements an Official
  Plan.
- That the fee for the processing of each application to the Committee of Adjustment be as set out on Schedule B attached hereto and forming part of this by-law.
- 4. That the compensation paid to the members of the Committee of Adjustment for attendance at meetings and for conducting Committee of Adjustment business be in accordance with Schedule C attached hereto and forming part of this by-law.
- 5. That this by-law shall come into force and effect upon the coming into force of the Planning Act, 1983.
- 6. That a certified copy of this by-law shall be sent to the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing by Registered Mail by the Clerk within thirty (30) days of the passing hereof.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 11th day of JULY, 1983.


