BY-LAW

Number _____ 220 -85

To make it lawful for any person to engage in or be present at certain activities on the Lord's Day (Bingo Lottery - Brampton Minor Baseball Association)

WHEREAS the Brampton Minor Baseball Association proposes to operate a bingo lottery on the dates set out in Schedule A to this by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton $\bar{\mathrm{E}}\mathrm{NACTS}$ as follows:

1. Subsection 1 (1) of the Lord's Day (Ontario) Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 253, as amended) is hereby declared to apply in the City of Brampton between 7:00 oclock and 10:30 o'clock in the evening on the dates set out in Schedule A to this by-law, in respect of the bingo lottery to be conducted by the Brampton Minor Baseball Association, at Brampton Bingo Country Project, 291 Rutherford Road South in Brampton.

2. All activities permitted by this by-law shall be conducted in an orderly manner.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 12th day of August, 1985.
