To repeal By-law 137-80

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton passed By-law 137-80 on the 26th day of May, 1980, declaring the lands described in Schedule A hereto to be required for municipal purposes, namely public parkland;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton passed By-law 211-87 on the 14th day of September, 1987, declaring the lands described in Schedule A hereto to be no longer required for municipal purposes and authorizing the sale of the lands to the abutting owners;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. By-law 137-80 is hereby repealed.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 28th day of September, 1987.

SCHEDULE A

The lands situated in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel, (formerly in the Town of Brampton, County of Peel) and being composed of part of Lot 84 according to a plan registered in the Land Registry Office for the Registry Division of Peel (No. 43) as Number 635, which said parcel may be more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the south-westerly angle of Lot 84.

Thence North 10 degrees 25 minutes East a distance of 29.08 feet.

Thence North 81 degrees 39 minutes 30 seconds East, a distance of 150.93 feet to a point in the Easterly limit of Lot 84, distant 46.64 feet measured Northerly from the Southeasterly angle thereof.

Thence South 7 degrees 46 minutes East along the Easterly limit of Lot 84, 46.64 feet to the South-easterly angle of Lot 84.

Thence South 88 degrees 28 minutes West a distance of 160.96 feet to the point of commencement.
