A by-law to establish a Churchville Heritage Conservation District Advisory Committee

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Brampton has adopted the Churchville Heritage Conservation District Plan dated May 1990, and has designated by by-law the Churchville Heritage Conservation District;

AND WHEREAS the Churchville Heritage Conservation District Plan calls for the establishment of a District Advisory Committee;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- A district advisory committee is hereby established, to be known as the "Churchville Heritage Conservation District Advisory Committee".
- 2) The Committee shall be appointed by Council and shall be composed of not fewer than seven (7), but not more than nine (9) members as follows:
 - (i) two (2) to four (4) district residents;
 - (ii) one (1) to two (2) Local ArchitecturalConservation Advisory Committee members;
 - (iii) one (1) municipal councillor; and

(iv) one (1) to two (2) members at large.

3) The aims and objectives of the Committee will be as follows:

to monitor the Churchville Heritage Conservation
District Plan for its effectiveness in guiding
the conservation of the district;

- (ii) to act as liaison for district residents, preparing, when necessary, materials that may assist in furthering the appreciation of Churchville's heritage;
- (iv) through the Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee, to advise Council on the appropriateness of changes proposed within the district through the administration of the permit application process; and,
- (v) through the Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee, to report to Council on an annual basis concerning the Committee's activities.
