



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 224-2005

To authorize the expropriation of certain lands for the purpose of a parking garage

WHEREAS Sections 5(3) and 6(1) of the Municipal Act 2001 require the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to pass a by-law for acquiring or expropriating any land required for the purposes of the Corporation;

AND WHEREAS the City of Brampton, as a lower tier municipality has jurisdiction to pass by-laws respecting municipal parking lots and structures pursuant to Section 11 of the Municipal Act, 2001;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is necessary and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to acquire the lands herein described for the purpose of constructing a parking structure.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The expropriation of the lands in the City of Brampton as described in Schedule A hereto attached, for the purpose of erecting a parking structure is hereby authorized.
2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton as expropriating authority, all notices, applications, advertisements and other documents required by the Expropriations Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.E.26, as amended, in order to effect the expropriation of the said lands.
3. If a request for a hearing of necessity of the proposed expropriation is received within the time limit prescribed in Section 6 of the Expropriations Act, the City Solicitor is hereby authorized to refer the matter to the Chief Inquiry Officer for a hearing and to attend the hearing with such witnesses as may be required to support the City's position.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 11th day of July, 2005.
